

DEED OF SEPARATION

THIS DEED is dated the 14th day of February 2001 and made BETWEEN **MR CHIN KANG KOR** (NRIC No. S1234567-H) (hereinafter called "the Husband") of the one part AND **MDM BOEY DAR HAN** (NRIC No.9876543-W) (hereinafter called "the Wife") of the other part.

WHEREAS :

- (A) The parties were married on 31 October 1998 at the Singapore Marriage Registry.
- (B) There are no children of the said marriage.
- (C) On or about 1 January 2001, the parties formed the intention to end their marriage and as from that date, they began living separate and apart from each other.
- (D) The parties now enter into this Deed to record the fact of their separation and the terms thereof.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH that the Husband and the Wife mutually covenant and agree with each other as follows :-

Living Apart

1. Since on or about 1 January 2001, the parties have been living separate and apart from each other by mutual agreement.

2. The parties shall continue to live separate and apart from each other as if each were single and unmarried.
3. Each party shall be free from the marital control of the other and neither shall annoy disturb or interfere with the other his or her relations friends or acquaintances and in his or her profession, job or business.
4. The Husband shall not any time require the Wife to cohabit with him and *vice versa*.

Divorce and Breakdown of Marriage

5. Neither party is to be blamed for the fact of separation and the breakdown of their marriage.
6. After January 2004, either party may present a Petition to the Subordinate Courts Family Court Division for Divorce on the ground that the marriage has irretrievably broken down in that the parties to the marriage have lived apart for a continuous period of at least three (3) years immediately preceding the presentation of the Petition and the respondent consents to a decree being granted (i.e. pursuant to Section 95(3)(d) of the Women's Charter, Cap 353 (Revised Edition 1997). The other party shall consent to the decree being granted.
7. Regardless who petitions for the dissolution of the marriage, the legal costs and expenses for the Divorce Petition shall be borne by the parties equally.

Maintenance

8. The Husband shall pay the Wife the sum of \$300-00 per month for her maintenance.

Interpretation

9. This Deed shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Singapore.
